EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The most important work happens in quieter moments, strengthening relationships, engaging communities, and laying the groundwork for deeper impact in the years ahead. For CyberData Foundation, 2025 was one of those important building years.

In 2025, CyberData Foundation made meaningful progress in advancing cybersecurity awareness and education within the community. During the year, the Foundation organized ten cybersecurity awareness sessions, providing practical knowledge on safe online practices and digital responsibility. Through these programs, more than 25 students received training designed to strengthen their understanding of cybersecurity and digital safety.

The Foundation also awarded four scholarships to support students pursuing cybersecurity and data science. In addition, three strategic partnerships were established with organizations that share our commitment to strengthening digital resilience and expanding access to cybersecurity education.

Equally important was establishing three strategic partnerships with organizations committed to digital resilience and cybersecurity education. These partnerships represent an important step in expanding the Foundation's collaborative network and creating new opportunities for joint programs, knowledge sharing, and future initiatives that will extend our reach and impact.

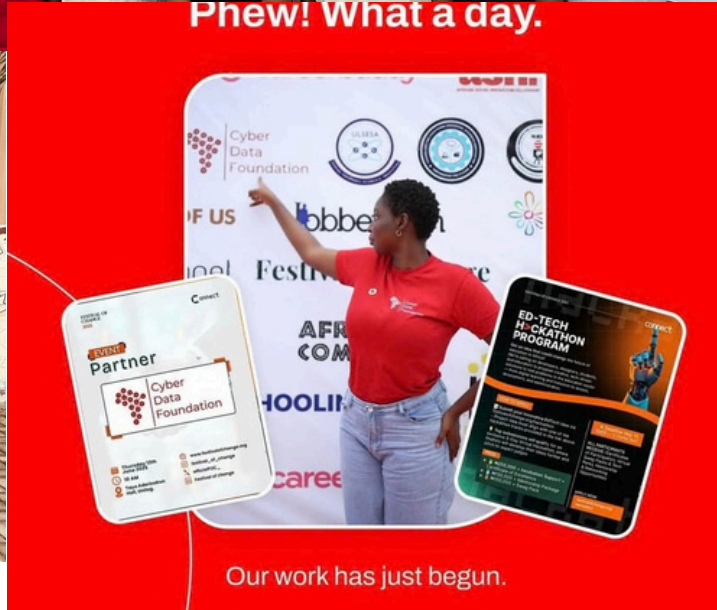
New Learning Resources and Improved Digital Presence
